Girls Incorporated of Limestone, Algonquin and Lakeshore granted \$14,262 through our community grants program

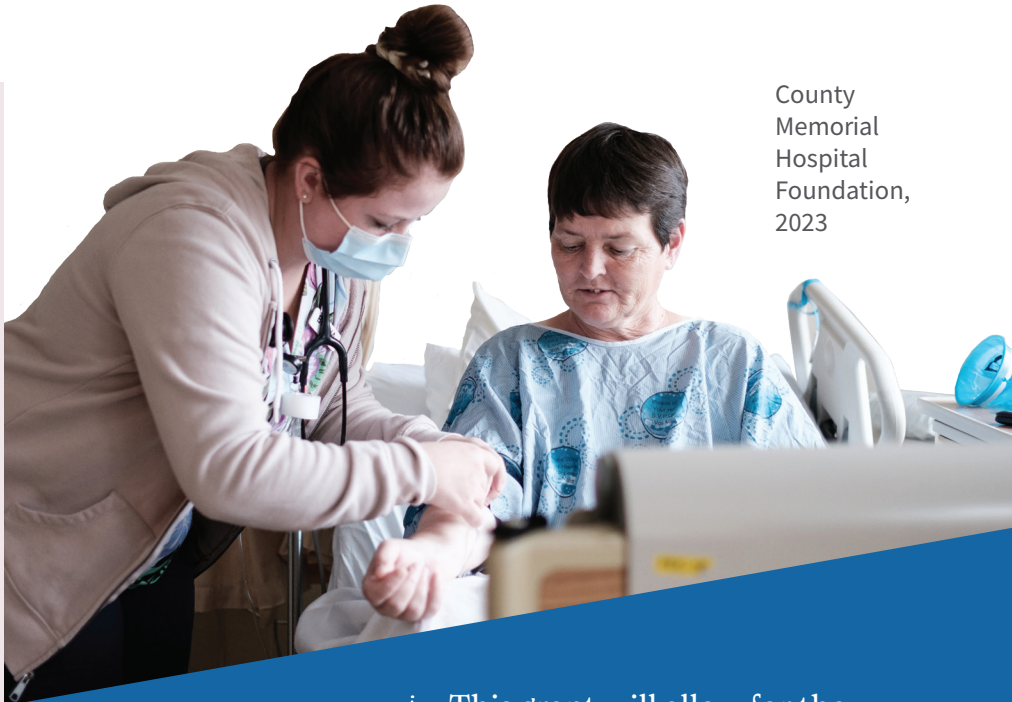
